Use only main references; e) **Tables and figures must not be included**; f) identify with an asterisk (\*) the author who is sending the abstract; g) Each paragraph should begin with 5 spaces typed on keyboard.

REFERENCES – The word **Reference** should be typed in Arial 11, bold; References list should begin 01 space after the word **Reference**.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS – Acknowledgements and financial/ support agency names should appear at the end of text, two simple spaces after the last line of abstract, aligned at right, uppercase letters for acronyms and uppercase/ lowercase for text; Bold, Arial 10; Do not type the word ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS.
